QUALIFICATIONS

Great tutors come from all walks of life. Whether you're 18 or 85, your most important qualification is a desire to help children succeed! That said, it's important that you meet the following minimum qualifications by the beginning of your service:

- Be 18 years or older
- Have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Be a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States²
- Have served fewer than four terms with AmeriCorps
- Have reliable transportation to travel between child care sites
